We hope all is well. Presented below is our latest Durian Projects Newsletter covering key news involving durian.

The big news in this edition of our newsletter is rapidly increasing Malaysian durian prices. Demand for Musang King and Black Thorn is fast surpassing available supply, which have been impacted by higher operating costs. Fertilisers costs have been the largest concern having dramatically increased due to the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Russia is the world's largest producer of fertilizer and economic sanctions, have limited its ability to export fertilizer and its raw ingredients. The country's exports account for 18% of the world potash market, 20% of ammonia sales and 15% of urea. Plus, a lot of the natural gas, the most expensive part of making fertilizers, comes from Russia.

Rising durian prices have also resulted in the Malaysian government considering placing durian price controls that will create more transparency and boost investment in supply. We are unsure if price controls will be agreed upon but Durian Projects has been expanding its plantations to meet growing overseas demand.
