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Musang King durian prices in Malaysia increase 29%

Durian prices are at a historical high with Musang King durian reaching RM90 per kg, compared with RM70 per kg last year, an increase of 29%. The price increase is a result of low fruit yield due to bad weather this season and increasing export demand from international markets.
