
We hope all is well. Presented below is our latest March Durian Projects Newsletter covering key news involving durian.

This month marked a special occasion for us, with the opening of our newly fitted office in Johor. The newly fitted office is in response to growing demand from clients to visit our durian project. China dominated in other news, with record breaking durian imports reported once again, despite COVID. In terms of value, China imported over RM 16.8 billion (USD 4 billion) in durian fruit in 2021. This is an astonishing increase of over 80% from the year before. China is planning for further increased imports from Malaysia, and has created Malaysia's first benchmark for quality standards. The standards were created in cooperation with Malaysia and numerous government bodies in China. They began on February 18th and will help boost trade between Malaysia and China significantly as it provides an easier way to educate wholesalers and the general public on the quality of Malaysian durian.

We look forward to more durian trade with China and expect all of Malaysia to benefit!
