## Malaysia's Penang to crack down on fake Balik Pulau durians

Penang has announced it is launching operations to stop the fraudulent practice of marketing and selling durians imported from other regions and Thailand as the Balik Pulau variety. These operations will involve the police, the Agriculture Department, and the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority working together to conduct raids and increasing inspections. The crackdown comes in response to public complaints from the consumers and local producers.
